Instructions	<p>The purpose of the exercise is to present in up in 280 characters (a tweet) a hypothetical digital story of a NEMESIS project.</p> <p>STEP1 Print and cut out all the pieces of paper that are in and organize them in four piles according to it category: theme, format, place and participants</p> <p>STEP 2 Each gamer choose randomly one element from each pile.</p> <p>STEP 3 Think about how you would present your digital story in 240 characters and complete the template.</p> <p>STEP 4 Everybody present their stories to the group</p>
